

Who can participate?

The VLC is open to all state, territorial, and local health departments.

A participant does not have to be from a jurisdiction that receives CDC's PS21-2103 funding to participate in the VLC.





How often will sessions take place?

VLC sessions will take place via Zoom twice per month on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays.





How do I participate?

Registration is easy. All PS21-2103 recipients and NASTAD members will receive notification once registration for the VLC sessions opens. Once registered, you'll begin receiving regular notifications about VLC session dates, times, and Zoom links.





Can I join both VLC Prevention and Surveillance Sessions?

Yes. Participants will have the option to participate in the VLC Prevention sessions, Surveillance sessions, or both sessions. Additionally, the curriculum includes joint sessions intended for both hepatitis prevention and surveillance staff.





Will VLC Sessions be recorded?

Yes. The sessions will be recorded and posted for all participants to access afterwards.





Can I still submit TA requests to HepTAC?

Absolutely! The VLC is a supplement to the services already provided by NASTAD's HepTAC. In addition to the VLC, NASTAD will maintain it's online system for submission of technical assistance requests, workgroup calls, newsletter, and other HepTAC programs and services.
