
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Training Curriculum Evaluation

To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements about the training?




<u>Theme:</u> Strengthening Partnerships




Asset Mapping & Goal Development





Mid-Cohort Assessment


How would you rate how each of the following items have changed since participating in the learning community?

- The people training us are great! Well informed. Also the format is designed for all, not just clinical





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
