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GO WITH THE VEIN FLOW

AND INJECT TOWARD THE HEART

Always inject into a vein and never into the muscle. Veins are close to the surface of the skin and spring to the touch. The veins closest to the surface in the body are not as visible as veins. If you are unsure, you will have to try an area until you find one that will look foamy. If this happens, stop and seek medical attention if the bleeding does not stop.

Arms usually have three veins. To find a vein, try using a soft tie or tourniquet. Use a safe tie so that you can easily remove it. If you are using a register (flag), do it before you push in the needle. If you are not using a register, make your fist when you push your fist in slow. Ask your SSP for other supplies.

BEVEL DOWN



THE BEVEL IS THE SHARPEST EDGE AT THE POINT OF THE SYRINGE

The only time the bevel should face down is when drawing up from a cooker. You can protect the bevel by using a cotton filter. This is common when one has their hands clean and their hands after using a hot cooker.

BEVEL UP

Position the syringe with the bevel facing up so the sharp tip can pierce the skin first, easing the way for the rest of the needle.

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CHASING WITH FOIL

ROCK/CRACK FOLDED MATH

Prepare a foil rectangle that is 1/2 inch wide and 1/4 inch high (the width of your foil). If the foil has a shiny, plastic coating, pre-burn the foil by a flame.

With the dull side facing down, place drugs on the foil and heat from the lighter a few inches below the foil.

CHASING WITH FOIL

Once this substance has liquefied, keep heating by holding your lighter. Make a hole in the new made of foil to chase the smoke. Take it slow, especially if it's your first time smoking or you haven't smoked in a while. Remember that it's still burning. If you stop smoking, give yourself a few minutes to see how you feel after that first inhale.

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GLASS STRAIGHT STEM

CRACK, ROCK COCAINE

Beats screens are best. Ask for them at your SSP. If screens are not like for your screen (Chore Boy) is better than steel wool, which can break apart and burn your mouth and throat when it gets hot. Pre-burn your scrubber to release the flames. If the screen was your own rubber mouthpiece (sporting cover or rubber bands).

GLASS BUBBLE PIPE

METH, FENTANYL

Inhale slow and exhale fast. Heat the pipe from under mouth and keep the flame moving around the bowl so you melt the drugs instead of burning them. The heat will cause the pipe to crackle and wastes less drug.

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BODY BUMPING

Mix drugs with 1-2 ml of clean water. Make sure drugs have dissolved completely—heating in a cooker can help. Break the point off a syringe (dispose of it safely) or use a lube applicator. Lube applicators are more effective because they are designed to deliver fluid to the rectal cavity, it also holds more liquid than a syringe.

WATER DRIPPING

Water dripping is more effective than sniffing (liquid helps absorption). Crush drugs as much as possible to reduce irritation. Water from best to worst: saline, distilled, bottled or tap. For a water solution, look for more water. For a water solution, look for more water. Break the point off a syringe (dispose of it safely) or use a dropper.

P.S. This only works for drugs that dissolve in water (like heroin, cocaine, crack, etc.). Water dripping does not work for crack or pills.

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IF DRUGS ARE IN YOUR OINT, YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT FENTANYL & NALOXONE

This is why some of the drugs are in your ointment and you need to know about them. It is up to you to use them in a safe way. If you are using them, you are using them. If you are using them, you are using them.

NALOXONE comes in a red and is used with an intramuscular syringe (23g, 30x1 inch). To avoid drawing up air, tip your syringe down.

MARCAN comes in a red and is used with a nasal spray. To avoid drawing up air, tip your syringe down.

There is no such thing as a "safe" overdose. Naloxone and Narcan will work on all opioid overdoses including fentanyl. (Narcan is a brand name for naloxone.)

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
