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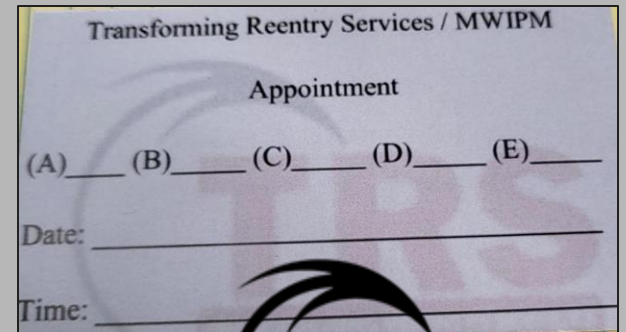
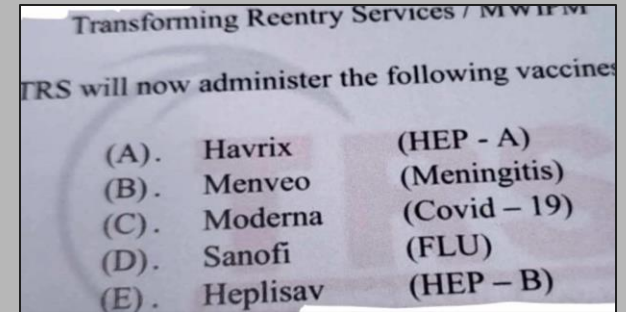
A little bit about us!

-  By felons for felons.
-  Only Black run & led SSP in Chicago providing services by and for Black communities in Chicago.
-  Began in 1989 when Rev. Green would go into prisons. Rev was also n the original group that worked to condoms into prions.
-  We provide Reentry services, Harm Reduciton, testing, mentoring, advocacy and more!



Outreach/services design

- ① **TRS** Combined outreach of Reentry (ID, Birth Cert), HIV, COVID-19 & Harm Reduction.
- ① **TRS** Delivery is an option for houses serving a lot of people or when direct services are not available.
- ① **TRS** Checking in with *gatekeepers* to create safety.
- ① **TRS** Vaccine cards.
- ① **TRS** Westside homeless shelters for vaccine administration & services.



Vaccine education

- ① **TRs** Worked for over 15 months in community before this project started.
- ① **TRs** Collecting feedback on vaccine hesitancy that informs the approach to education.
- ① **TRs** Acknowledge community distrust due to historical medical abuse of community.
- ① **TRs** Ongoing cultivation of relationships & trust in community.
- ① **TRs** People seem to be more interested in MPX vaccine than COVID-19 vaccines.



Vaccine practices

- Ⓜ Peer to peer vaccine training. We can train each other- minimal government barriers.
- Ⓜ How to obtain, store, track and administer have preestablished regulations.
- Ⓜ Established regular schedule informed by participants & capacity.
- Ⓜ No clinic staff required. Only standing order required- similar to HIV/HCV testing.
- Ⓜ Created more training & oversight than what is required.
