



Using Afro-Rithms to Heal






Ancestral Bracelet

Neal Stephenson's novel *Snowcrash* established the dystopian concept of the Metaverse in June, 1992.

One year later, in August 1993, C. Tsehloane Keto argued that the only way forward is a global pluriverse that respects our innovation and a nonhegemonic approach that embraces our humanity.

While technology corporations race to make that dystopia a reality, the Black Angel of History offers responses to the future challenges of the Metaverse with Cyberfunk worldbuilding and Pluriverse flair of the Astro-Black Speculative design imagination.

My idea for Critical Race Design Studies presents one such response to these emergent technocultural challenges...

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... an interdisciplinary design practice that intersects critical race theory, speculative design, design history, and critical making to analyze and critique the effects of vicual communication, graphic objects,
