PrEP Iowa provides Prevention Navigation Services in partnership with Iowa's existing public health infrastructure and Iowa's TelePrEP program. For individuals in need of PrEP/nPEP the Navigator will work at the individual level to assess needs and link individuals to the most appropriate points of care. For those who are uninsured, underinsured, or otherwise seeking confidential services (insurance averse) labs can be obtained at a local public health partner site without cost and medications can be prescribed and managed through Iowa's safety-net telehealth program without cost. Medications are filled through pharmacy partners and billed to a patients insurance or to other available assistance programs with process support provided by the Navigator.	PrEP is available at the Howard County Health Department through the Reproductive Health Clinic. Call 410-313-7500 for more information.	Both the MA PrEP Drug Assistance Program (PrEPDAP) & the MA nPEP Program are administered through a contract with a CBO (Community Resource Initiative (CRI)), however they are structured differently. PrEPDAP enrolls individuals whereas nPEP enrolls sites that have agreed to ensure that there is no other payer for PEP, or that the individual who needs nPEP is not able to use their insurance due to confidentiality concerns. This is to allow for rapid access to nPEP due to the 72 hour window after a high risk exposure.		Project SPICY is location based out of seven NMDOH public health offices across the state (Albuquerque, Santa Fe, Farmington, Gallup, Las Cruces, Carlsbad, Artesia/Roswell). SPICY does not charge co-pays for medical visits, labs, or medication fills, so it is free to participants regardless of public, private or no insurance covered. Clients documentation status is not considered in eligibility. You can contact each public health office directly and ask for Project SPICY and they can arrange an appointment.				The Integrated Participating Provider Agreement (PPA) provides reimbursement for clinical visits along with laboratory support for Uninsured individuals for PrEP and for uninsured and underinsured individuals for PEP.
